## First Year Law Rep By-Election Information

### How to Apply:

To be eligible to apply for the above positions, you **must**:

1. Be a member of the UTS LSS. Become a member by following all the prompts [here](#).
2. Be a first year law student. This position is only open to first year law students.

To apply, please send a Statement of Candidature to [president@utslss.com](mailto:president@utslss.com) and [secretary@utslss.com](mailto:secretary@utslss.com) by **5pm on Thursday, 9 April 2020**. Candidates are strongly encouraged to also submit a Video Pitch, in addition to their Statement of Candidature. Any statements and videos sent after this time will not be considered.

A Statement of Candidature is a statement that reflects:

- Who you are (your full name, student number, student email address);
- A picture of yourself (optional);
- The position you are nominating yourself for;
- Any experience that will assist you in the capacity of your nominated position;
- What you will bring to the position during tenure if you are elected; and
- What you will assist this Council in achieving if you are elected.

The requirements for the Statement of Candidature are as follows:

- No more than one A4 page;
- Times New Roman;
- Size 12 font;
- 1.5 spacing;
- 2cm margins;
- Submitted in word format; and
- Must include your full name, student number, student email address, and the nominated position.

In addition to a Statement of Candidature, candidates are strongly encouraged to also submit a video pitch. A Video Pitch is a short video that:

- Introduces yourself; and
- Explains why you want the position for which you are nominating.

Candidates have full creative direction as to what they include and how they create the Video Pitch, provided it conforms to the requirements noted below.

The requirements for the Video Pitch are as follows:

- Must include your full name, student number, student email address, and the nominated position;
- No more than 1-minute long; and
- Submitted as a link to a youtube video.
